# **Goal of Adult Leaders**

We are all called to pass along the faith and mentor young people. Research shows that students who have multiple deep relationships with adults throughout their formative years get better grades, have higher aspirations for the future, and stay connected to the Church when they reach adulthood. The goal of Adult Leaders is to have a team of people who invest in our students, helping lead and teach during weekly events, visioning for the future of the ministry, and supporting the families throughout the year.

### **Requirements:**

- Express care for students; Show that you want what is best for them.
- Be dependable.
- Challenge students to grow.
- Provide support.
- Listen.
- Involved in the life of the church and committed to growing in your faith.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Sign up to attend an event at least 4 days before via the online sign up document.
- Arrive at least 30 minutes before the start of ministry for prayer & instructions.
- Engage and welcome students as they arrive for ministry.
- Assist and/or lead games and/or discussions during ministry time.
- Lead small groups when necessary.
- Participate in games and conversation as much as possible.
- Help keep students safe and on task.
- Help clean up after an event and stay onsite until all students have left.
- Connect with students and parents when seen outside of ministry time.
- Always be looking for and inviting new adults to join the team.
- Always be looking for and inviting new students to come to the ministry.
- If you signed up for ministry and then are unable to make it, please find a replacement.
- Help communicate to students, families, and the congregation what the students are doing in ministry.
- Help the team continue to grow and move towards our vision and goals.

- Sunday afternoons for 3-6 hours as you are available (ideally, at least once a month).
- Summer Adult Leadership Weekend Retreat.
- January Adult Leadership Meeting.
- Possible retreats, lock-ins, and mission trips (as available).
